You don't want to be involved in a bad pass or be the one who dropped the baton. It hurts the team and, of course, your ego.

When you first heard of Christ, did you pass the Good News on? Why or why not? Have you ever wondered who gave the Good News to the one who passed it on to you? Why do you think they passed it on? What if they didn't pass it on to you? Would that have made a difference in your life?

When you have the opportunity to pass the Good News, is it done clearly and with enthusiasm or do you drop the opportunity and hope someone else will come along and pass the baton?

Let's pray there is someone behind us who is willing to pass the Good News on because of our failure to do so.

Since Jesus decided to not only pass the Good News on to his disciples but also to set an example, those who believed and lived the Good News in Christ's time passed it on down through the ages until it arrived in one form or another to us.

Shouldn't we do the same so that someone will pass it on after we are gone?

He was also present in the photo of grampa's headstone my grandson sent because seeing the note made him want to go and visit grampa, just to talk to him and tell him of his college plans.

God is present in members who care enough to check on other members they haven't seen at worship in a while, or to stop during fellowship time to pray with someone going through a struggle. God is also there in the love of members who go to FMSC, NIFB or P.A.D.S. and in the smile of the team leaders who stand by the ministry tables to invite them.

### **GREEN TREES APARTMENTS, OUR NEIGHBORS**

WORK PROJECT - SATURDAY JUNE 1 8;30 AM (Come when you can, leave when you must.)

**FOOD** - Cofffee & Donuts in AM, Brats & Ice Cream at noon

LOCATION - 11417 E Main St, Huntley (at Main St & Donald Dr)

Most of us have passed by this little development just .5 miles west of



Shepherd of the Prairie on Main St, and never even knew it was there (or what it was).

Green Trees is a housing development, owned and managed by the McHenry County Housing Authority. Occupancy is limited to those who are disabled or those with low incomes.

Funding for this housing is always limited. As a result, organizations have provided support in such areas as painting, window washing, trimming, etc.

Over the years SOTP has provided help in many areas, all on a onetime single project basis.

In 2012, the County was given a special grant to landscape the property. SOTP was asked to oversee this project. With the involvement of many other community organizations, over 1,000 trees and shrubs were planted. The Village of Huntley supplied the Mulch. Many organizations such as Boy Scouts, Trinity Lutheran, St Mary's, provided help.

This was done with a "one time" involvement of SOTP.

Please note that a project like this provided SOTP with "Mission" opportunities right in our community and for peoples of all generations to interact.

Unfortunately, no one gave much thought as to how this property was going to be maintained. Weeds were higher than the plantings and there was the most colorful field of dandelions. So, SOTP was asked to help, again on a "one time" basis, and the weeds were brought somewhat under control.

Members of our Mission Team made a decision to support with manpower and some funding the ongoing maintenance of Green Trees. Jules Pelka volunteered to coordinate efforts at Green Trees.

We have enlisted the help of a number of Community orgnizations & churches. Please come and help!!!

### AARK GARDEN FRESH VEGGIES

The AARRK Garden is a farm ran to support the homeless located in Hebron Illinois. Many homeless also work on the farm.

The AARRK Garden is offering to sell their fresh grown produce to SOTP members. If we can get more than 5 orders, they will deliver fresh produce bags to the church weekly.



This will run from the beginning of June and then for the next 15-20 weeks (*based on weather and produce availability*)

This is an upfront one time cost of \$200.00. For this amount you will get a produce bag delivered to SOTP weekly. Each week your bag will be different based on what is picked fresh that week at the farm. The bags start out smaller at the beginning and grown much larger

as the summer goes on. Each bag will feed between 2-4 people.

A sample of some of the items they grow are: peppers, tomatoes, cucumbers, beans, peas, onions, potatoes, carrots, sweet potatoes, pumpkins, zucchini, okra, eggplant, cabbage and broccoli. For more information, please see the Mission Board
