

A Note From Pastor Mark

Dear Friends at Shepherd of the Prairie Lutheran Church:

Here we go again out into the "wilderness."

The season of Lent invites us on a journey of 40 days of reflecting upon the mercy show by God through Jesus Christ. Mercy is our theme which will guide our midweek services beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 2. We encourage you to join us.

The story of Jesus' temptation in the

wilderness sticks in our memory as a great example of Godly strength by God's son, Jesus. But at the end of Jesus' forty days, we find a warning: "(the devil) left him until an opportune time" (verse 13).

We need to be aware that the devil is never very far away from each of us. He waits in the wings to take advantage of the

opportunity when we are weakest. And he rejoices in our falling down and in our failings. He longs to reign in our feelings of rejection, discouragement, and despair.

One of the many places where mercy appears if from the prophet Joel. We use these words in our liturgy during the season of Lent. "Return to the Lord your God, for God is gracious and merciful. Slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love. God

assures us in the Bible that "God is with us always"

(Matthew 28:20) and also that God sends a host of angels to be with us (Psalm 91:11-12). Certainly, even after Jesus faced temptation in the wilderness God sent angels to minister to Jesus.

God's Word confirms that "in our weakness God is strong" (Isaiah 40:29-31). Jesus tells us, "Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid" (Luke 14:27). Jesus prays to God for our protection in John 17 (verses 11 and 15). And when we need


the right words, the Holy Spirit will give them to us (Luke 12: 11-12).

With those helpful words, with the example of Jesus, and with other godly friends, we can be strong and bold, and invite the Holy Spirit to keep us from caving in when confronted with temptations.

Take some time to think about times when you've been helped or had the opportunity to be a helper through troubled days. How did those situations impact you? Others? Ponder how in those times you have experienced God's mercy and how by the Spirit power you have extended mercy (Luke 6:36).

Love your neighbor

Recently I read again Jesus' words, "Love your neighbor as yourself." These words are found in all three synoptic gospels, Matthew, Mark and Luke.

As I pondered the meaning of those words, I thought about the times I've heard people (and myself) criticize others for not following those words of Jesus. We usually assume those

words mean the same as, "do to others as you would have them do to you" (Luke 6: 31).

But I wonder if many times

when we treat others in less than

generous ways, if we are actually loving them as we really do love ourselves. If we are self-critical, self-demeaning, self-shaming we most likely are treating others the same. Many of us may actually love others more than we love ourselves, or at least we treat them better than we treat ourselves.

I know of people who lie awake for hours going over and over words they said that day and wondering how deeply they may have wounded someone. But when we tell ourselves terrible things about our self, do we realize the pain in us? I'm not advocating for narcissism, or over inflation our own egos; but so many of us look in the mirror, or into our minds and begin a litany of depreciation. My face is too round, my hair is too thin, look at all those wrinkles, I'm too fat, I'm too thin, if only I was taller...or shorter; older or younger. I wish I was smarter, better educated, stronger, braver, less anxious, quieter, more outgoing...and the list goes on. Some of us hold on to anger or wounds from years ago unable to forgive and move on; and that anger or pain becomes like rust on a piece of iron, slowly eroding away all the joy and goodness in our lives until we are left as an angry,

bitter.


On a recent TV "makeover" show, the person receiving the makeover was an ELCA pastor. He kept "beating himself up" over something he had done and couldn't get past it. One of the Bishops invited to be part of his makeover gently took his face in her hands and asked, "If a member of your parish had done this same thing would you tell them how bad they were and what a failure they were?". Pastor Noah answered, "No, of course not". Bishop Megan said, "Then why are you saying those things to yourself, Child of God?"

That scene touched me so much. Since I saw that, every time I start to harangue myself over something I've done or left undone, I hear those words in my mind, "Then why are you saying those things to yourself, Child of God!!" We need to remind ourselves that God calls us God's child, with whom God is well pleased. I remember being in a large gathering and the speaker said, "There is nothing you can do to make God love more than he already does; and nothing you can do to make him love vou less". Truer words were never spoken.




